Optional: As part of the DSSS module, DS can offer the PhD student, among others, the following courses to choose from: 1) Interdisciplinarity in theory and practice - 30 hours, lecture / workshop, 2 ECTS 2) Ethics in interdisciplinary research – 15 h, lecture/workshop, 1 ECTS.
	MODULE 2. METHODOLOGICAL TRAINING – Methodology of social studies
	As part of the module, a PhD student is obliged to obtain at least 7 ECTS. Obligatory: 1) Methodology of social studies – 30 h, workshop, 2 ECTS. Optional: As part of the module, DSSS may offer PhD student the following courses to choose from: 1) Scientific research methods – 30 h, workshop, 2 ECTS; 2) Specialist courses in analysis of qualitative data (as part of the subject, DS may offer/PhD student may choose courses 10-, 15- or 30-hour long) – 1-2 ECTS depending on the course; 3) Specialist courses in analysis of quantitative data (as part of the subject, DS may offer/PhD student may choose courses 10-, 15- or 30-hour long) – 1-2 ECTS depending on the course; 4) Interdisciplinary research project – 30 h, project, 3 ECTS; 5) Interdisciplinary social and educational project – 30 h, project, 3 ECTS.

MODULE 3. ACADEMIC COMPETENCIES – Conditions for developing scientific career

As part of the module, a PhD student is obliged to obtain at least 8 ECTS.

Obligatory:

- 1) Language competence (B2) criterion art. 186
- 2) Training in occupational Health and Safety, 4 h, 0 ECTS.

Optional:

As part of the module, DS may offer PhD student the following courses to choose from:

- 1) Course in a modern foreign language on level C1, 4 ECTS;
- 2) Raising funds for research and managing research projects—20 h, workshop, 2 ECTS;
- 3) Intellectual property protection and ethics in conducting scientific research 15 h, discussion session, 1 ECTS;
- 4) Dissemination and popularization of research findings 15 h, workshop, 2 ECTS;
- 5) Workshops developing scientific cooperation skills, scientific career management and self-development planning 15 h, workshop, 2 ECTS;
- 6) Scientific career management 30 h, discussion session, 3 ECTS;
- 7) Work in research teams and fundamentals of project organization 15 h, workshop, 2 ECTS;
- 8) Social sciences for economy and business 15 h, discussion session, 1 ECTS;
- 9) Academic writing 15-30 h, workshop, 1-2 ECTS;
- 10) Publishing research papers 15 h, workshop, 1 ECTS.

MODULE 4 – PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES AND SOFT SKILLS, INCLUDING PREPARATION FOR TEACHING

As part of the module, a PhD student is obliged to obtain at least 5 ECTS.

Obligatory:

1) Teaching practice specified by Practice Regulations – 10 h per year, 40 h for the entire duration of studies, 1 ECTS per year = 4 ECTS for the entire duration of studies.

Optional:

As part of the module, DS may offer PhD student the following courses to choose from: 1) Fundamentals of academic teaching – 30 h, discussion session, 3 ECTS; 2) Modern information and communication technologies in academic teaching – 15 h, workshop, 1 ECTS: 3) Voice emission with elements of rhetoric – 15 h, workshop, 1 ECTS; 4) Academic tutoring – 15 h, workshop, 1 ECTS; 5) Modern methods and techniques for running classes – 15 h, workshop, 1 ECTS; 6) Interpersonal communication – 15 h, workshop, 1 ECTS; 7) Impression management and public speaking – 30 h, workshop, 2 ECTS; 8) Designing classes – 15 h, workshop, 1 ECTS. Rules for verification of acquisition of competencies on PhD student may prove achieving the intended learning outcomes as part of classes offered by the Level 8 of the Polish Qualification Framework as part of Doctoral School in the Social Sciences, included in education modules, as well as a result of their own classes and outside them, including rules for passing activity carried out outside classes. In the latter case the outcomes are confirmed by the Head of DP on the modules realized at other universities/universities abroad basis of the submitted application for credit award, on account of activities carried out outside the DSSS and for certifying education outcomes realized outside of the JU, which includes: the type of activity (research or teaching), justification of thereof, confirmation classes of its implementation as part of the doctoral programme, as based on the Supervisor's opinion and the decision of Doctoral Committee, should it be appointed. 1. A doctoral student may pursue courses dedicated to his doctoral programme, doctoral school and other courses organized by the Jagiellonian University and by other domestic and foreign institutions. 2. The number of ECTS points awarded for completing a course or training outside the Jagiellonian University is determined by the programme manager, as based on the doctoral student's declaration on the contribution of work, i.e. the number of contact hours, remote work and their own work required to complete the course or training. 3. A given activity (e.g. writing a scientific article) may be a confirmation of the acquisition of several learning outcomes, and for this form of verification, ECTS points may be awarded only once. In the case of multiple implementation of a given form of verification of learning outcomes (e.g. writing several scientific articles), ECTS points may be awarded for each of them.
